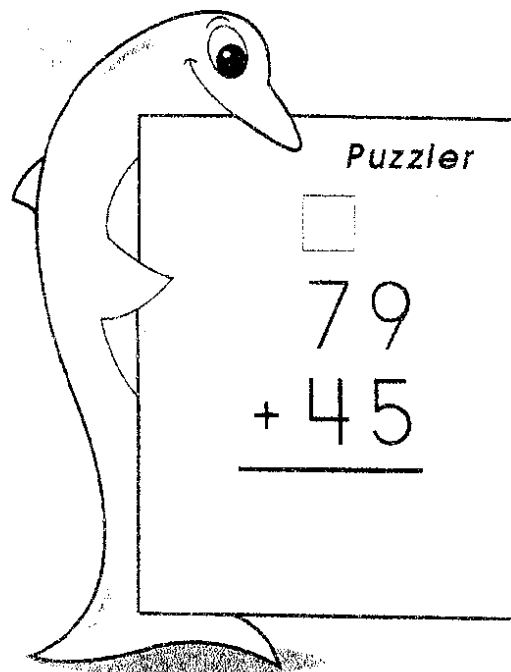

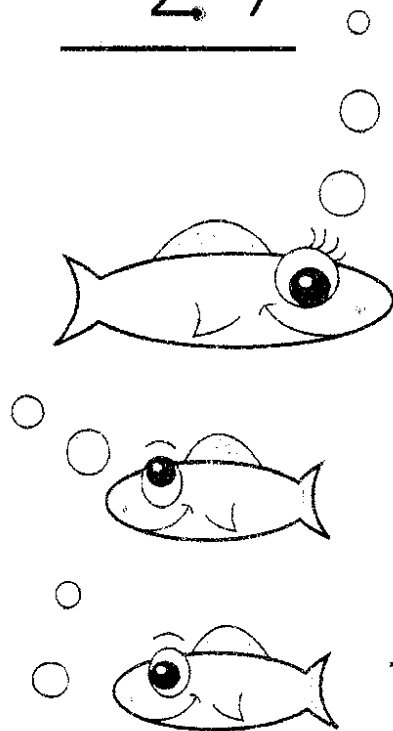

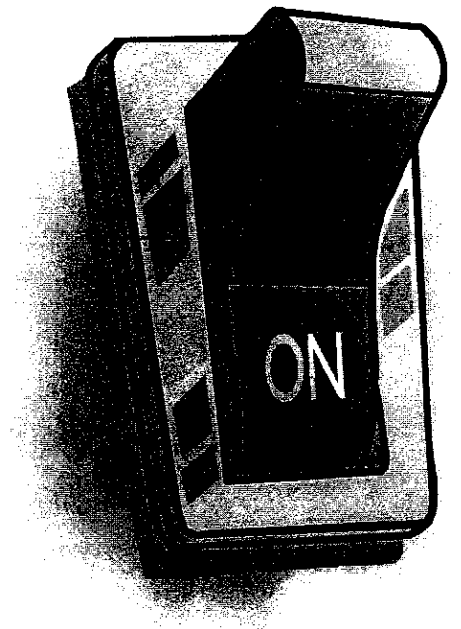
# I Say One Thing, You Say Another

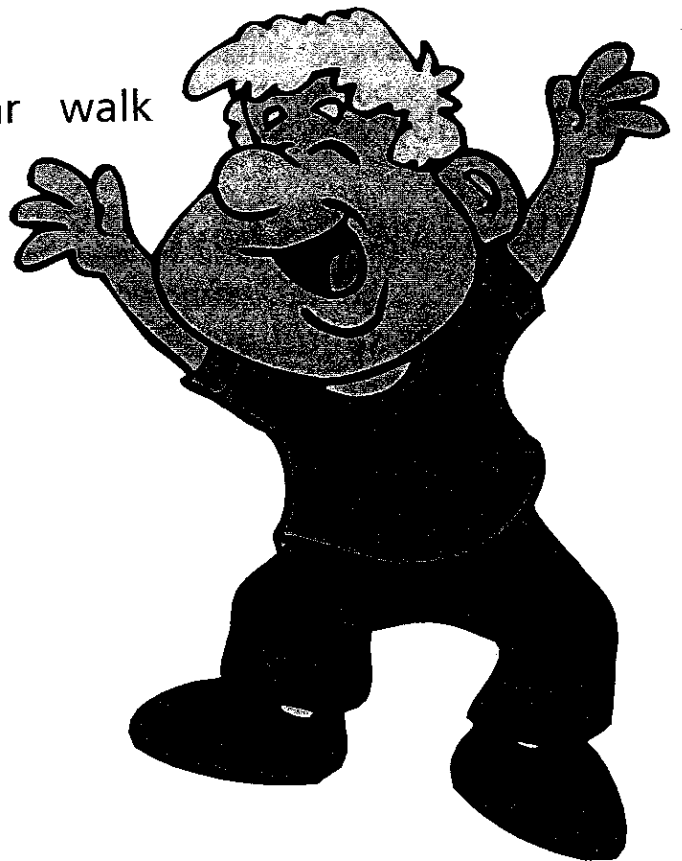

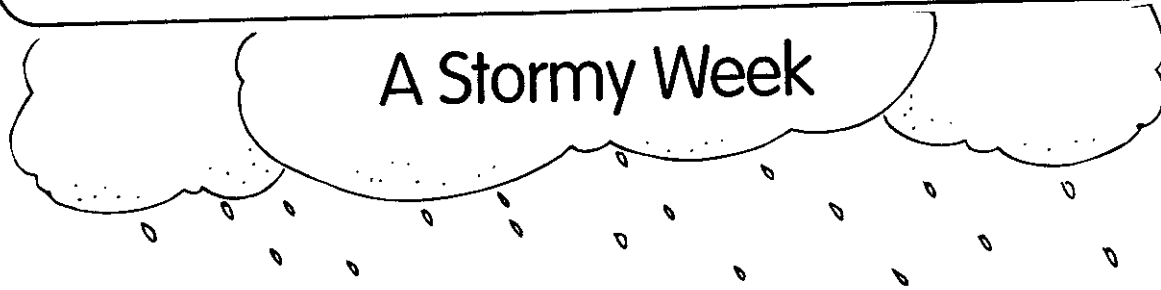
